Shri N.C. Sikri was a senior advocate and an alumna of CLC. A well-accomplished lawyer, who primarily practised at the Supreme Court of India and Delhi High Court, but had the distinction of appearing in almost all High Courts in India.

About the Essay Competition

Topics:

- (a) Judicial backlog: Can Artificial Intelligence be the answer?
- (b) People's Trust in the Indian Legal System: Whether at crossroads?
- (c) Gender Stereotypes: Whether Indian Legislature has played its role?



Prizes for Winners:

Ist Prize: Certificate and cash/cheque prize of Rs. 20,000 (Rupees Twenty Thousand)
2nd Prize: Certificate and cash/cheque prize of Rs. 15,000 (Rupees Fifteen Thousand)
3rd Prize: Certificate and cash/cheque prize of Rs. 10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand)
Consolation Prize: Certificate and cash/cheque prize of Rs. 5000 (Rupees Five Thousand)

Eligibility

The competition is open only to the students pursuing an LL.B. from CLC and the registered alumni of CLC of 2022, 2021, 2020, 2019 and 2018 batches.

Guidelines for Submission

- The Participant may select any topic of his choice amongst the topics above-mentioned.
- The essays must be submitted in English only.
- The topic should be mentioned at the top of the essay.
- The author's name should not be mentioned anywhere in the essay.
- The submission shall be made only in MS -Word format (.doc/.docx). PDF form shall not be accepted.
- The essay should be the original work of the author.
- The essay should not be plagiarised and be free from grammatical, spelling and other errors.
- The essays published elsewhere or selected/ submitted for publication elsewhere shall be disqualified.
- The abstract should not be more than 250 words.
- The word limit for the essay is 3000-4000 words, including footnotes.
- The essays should be typed in: Times New Roman, with Font Size 12 and Line Spacing 1.5.
- Headings: Times New Roman, Font Size 14, Bold.
- The footnotes must be typed in: Times New Roman, Font Size 10 and Line Spacing.
- The margins should be 1" or 2.54 cm on all sides. All text should be justified.
- Any uniform method for citation may be followed.
- Co-authorship is not permitted.



Submission Procedure

The submission has to be e-mailed to clcaadu18@gmail.com with the following three attachments:-

1. The Essay:

- It may be attached in '.doc' or '.docx' format.
- Participant shall name the attachment file as "Participant's name".

2. A separate Cover page containing:

- Name of the Author
- Class, Roll no. & Year <u>OR</u> Batch/year
- E-mail address & Contact No. of the Author

3. Copy of:

- College ID-Card, in case of current students
- Consolidated Mark-Sheet, and CLCAA Membership Proof in case of an alumnus.

At the time of submission of the essay, the alumnus must have acquired the membership.

4. Subject of the email should be "Submission: 4th N.C. Sikri Memorial Essay Competition, 2023".

5. The e-mail's body must specify the author's name and contact no.
